VII. Project Updates

The following is an update from the Chief Executive Officer/General Manager on the status of several items at the Agency.

I. Engagement Activities

The Board of Directors, Heather Dyer, and staff have participated in multiple community and industry events in recent months to highlight the on-going priorities of the Strategic Plan. Activities have included:

- June 18 The Agency hosted the fourth Sunrise Ranch Community Workshop for community members to have an opportunity to share feedback and learn more about visioning efforts underway for the property and next steps.
- June 20 The Agency participated in Yucaipa Valley Water District's Wochholz Regional Water Recycling Facility Groundbreaking ceremony for construction of additional microgrid equipment by providing remarks on the Watershed Connect effort and the regional benefits of programmatic WIFIA funding strategy.
- July 15 The Agency participated in the ESRI 2024 User Conference by giving a
 presentation to the Senior Executive Summit session highlighting the importance of
 connecting and collaborating beyond boundaries through shared vision, data, and
 collective efforts to reach water supply reliability and watershed resilience.

II. Forecast Informed Reservoir Operations at Seven Oaks Dam

Staff continues to collaborate with UC San Diego/Scripps Institute and their Center for Western Weather and Water Extremes (CW3E) on technical studies of Forecast Informed Reservoir Operations (FIRO) at Seven Oaks Dam. These studies include assessing locations for new observation (monitoring) locations in the watershed area tributary to Seven Oaks Dam. The additional observation locations will provide additional data on streamflow rates, soil moisture and precipitation.

III. Santa Ana Sucker Published Article

IV. CSUSB Institute for Watershed Resiliency- Regional Water Fellowship

We have begun working with Institute for Watershed Resiliency staff to prepare for recruitment of five new Regional Water Fellows based on the sponsorship approved by the Board of Directors in the FY 2024-25 General Fund Budget. Efforts are also underway to develop a program plan for activities to take place throughout the academic year. Once

selected, the new group of student fellows will be scheduled for formal introductions during a future Board Meeting.

V. Staffing Updates

Several recruitments are underway based on the approved FY 24-25 budget and staff positions. Our team is working hard to review application materials, schedule and hold interviews. We hope to have announcements about new team members coming soon.
