

Notice of Extended Public Review Comment Period for the Draft Environmental Impact Report for the Upper Santa Ana River Tributaries Restoration Project and Mitigation Reserve Program

Notice is hereby given that San Bernardino Valley Municipal Water District (Valley District) pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) is extending the public review period for the Draft Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for the Upper Santa Ana River Tributaries Restoration Project and Mitigation Reserve Program along the Upper Santa Ana River in the cities of Riverside and Jurupa Valley and in Riverside County. The proposed project would re-establish, enhance, rehabilitate, and/or preserve jurisdictional aquatic resource habitat and/or improve conditions for Santa Ana sucker at Anza Creek, Old Ranch Creek, Lower Hole Creek, and Hidden Valley Creek. The initial forty-five (45) day review and comment period is being extended to provide additional opportunity for the public to submit comments on the Draft EIR. Comments on the environmental document must now be submitted by 5:00 p.m. on June 14, 2019.
