

Inland Empire Grasses

These grasses thrive in our Mediterranean climate. Needing little water or care, these beautiful plants will provide you with year-round color and interest!

- 1 Louis Edmunds Manzanita *Arctostaphylos bakeri 'Louis Edmunds'*. This native shrub is a companion plant for grasses and attracts hummingbirds.
 - 2 Feather Reed Grass *Calamagrostis x acutiflora 'Karl Foerster'*. This feather reed grass is most notable for its fall accent character.
- 3 Purple Three-Awn *Aristida purpurea*. California native that produces colorful purple flowers and seed inflorescences.
 - 4 Pink Muhly *Muhlenbergia capillaris 'Regal Mist'*. Produces a profusion of pink-rose flower panicles in late summer.
 - 5 Blue Grama Grass *Bouteloua gracilis 'Blonde Ambition'*. Unique grass that waves gracefully in the breeze.
